



## **Tech Day: April 7<sup>th</sup> 2024**

### **Learn the basics of Garmin Basecamp, and integration with Garmin Navigators**

**What:** A four hour class that would go over the basics of setting up, and using Garmin Basecamp with the Garmin series navigators (BMW Nav 4-6, Zumo XT, older Zumo and Nuvi series)

Show how to setup the navigator to follow the routes that you planed, and why they can be different.

This Class will be a follow along type class where I will be able to project my computer screen to a monitor, while you will be able to follow along with your own laptop and navigator (It is not required to have your own laptop or navigator at the training. You can use the info for when you get home). There will be plenty of ability for Q and A to makes sure we are able to assist in getting people the information they need.

We will show best practices to build routes and tracks (*and explain the pros and cons of each*) with Basecamp that would be able to used with your navigation unit for single, and multi-day rides.

Show how to send files between the computer and navigator, and file management.

Show how to setup your navigator to show the routes and tracks you just built, and how to make sure it **actually** follows the route you planned!

**Prerequisites:** Garmin Basecamp gets the maps via the navigator and "Garmin Express". These maps are HUGE (about 4-5 Gig!) and need to be downloaded and installed prior to this class. I am willing to help people get their systems setup prior to the training, but if the maps are not updated prior to this class, there will likely be some substantial problems (these maps can take an hour to load with highspeed internet, and unfortunately are locked so each person needs to download the maps into their navigators **AND** Basecamp before the class starts.)
